

## PARENT AND SUPPORTER CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct has been developed by the Metro Jets Netball Club Committee and applies to all parents and supporters of the Metro Jets Netball Club. It outlines the standard of behaviour expected from parents and supporters, and is intended to ensure a safe, fair, and enjoyable environment within the netball community.

## **CONDUCT**

1. Actively support the efforts of all officials, coaches, managers, and volunteers and treat them with respect.

They give up their own time and do their best to assist in the development and enjoyment of players within the guidelines set by the Club.

2. Encourage players to participate and to play by the rules of the game.

Support fair play.

3. Never ridicule or scold a player for making a mistake or if they lose a game.

Professional sports people make mistakes.

4. Applaud all team performances regardless of win/loss.

In many cases a loss can provide an effective learning tool.

5. Respect the umpire's decisions and encourage players to do the same.

Have you ever umpired a sport? Even professional umpires make mistakes.

6. Treat opponents, their officials and supporters with respect.

Be a positive role model.

7. Remain on the sidelines throughout the match and in break time.

Your support on the sidelines is vital however during the match and breaks your child should remain with their team and coach.

8. Do not coach from the sideline.

This can be distracting and counterproductive.

- 9. Should behaviour of parent and supporters not meet these standards you may be asked to leave the game.
- 10. Repetitive poor behaviour from any party may result in being asked to leave the club.
