You will be responsible for:

- Overseeing the development of skills and the progression of players within the age group in line the Netball Australia's Skill Development Framework
- Monitoring player's performance, conditioning and skill development and encourage players to reach their full potential on and off the court
- Provide a safe environment for players to and builds on skill development, tactical awareness, teamwork and enjoyment of the game
- Creating an inclusive environment for children and their families where Teamwork, Respect, Unity and Excellence drive results
- Assisting the Premier League Coach and High Performance Coaching Team to ensure development opportunities are provided for the Premier League Squad and the AMND playing group

Responsibilities continued

- Coach the Metro Jets Premier League Reserves Team within the guidelines of the competition
- Comply with NSA and MJNC Coaches Code of Conduct
- Coordinate player development activities for junior skill advancement
- Liaise with Inter 1 & Premier League Coach to schedule and identify athletes to participate in the Inters Pathway Program each year
- Represent Metro Jets in club promotional and sponsorship activities
- Assist in the management of the selection processes for the premier league and premier league reserves players
- Co-ordinate MJNC elite player development programs including High Development Performance skills based training
- Liaise with Coaches co-ordinator to provide coach development at the MJNC to ensure accreditation and best business practises are adhered to
- Manage the recruitment of players in consultation with the Premier League Coach and Management Committee
- Provide game day coaching expertise and leadership
- Identify player strengths and weaknesses and provide timely and relevant feedback to them along with a recruitment profile to supplement any perceived deficiencies
- Report to the Management Committee and attend meetings when required
- Use the Metro Jets Club Statistics template to capture game day action to help identify and highlight player/team strengths and areas that needs improvement
- Encourage and support players to trial for representative and state programs and participate in club pathway program
